COI HEALTH DEPARTMENT

Lauren shared that there have been a few mosquito-borne and tick-borne diseases reported. The City has also seen multiple shigella cases.

REVIEW OF AMR EMERGENCY RESPONSES

Mac shared August 2024 numbers for AMR. AMR saw 89.52% compliance in response time with lowest in District 3 at 84%.

REVIEW OF FIRE EMERGENCY RESPONSES

DuPlantis shared that Fire saw slightly better numbers in August than is average; however, lowest numbers remain in District 3.

MEDICAL DIRECTOR REPORT
