COI HEALTH DEPARTMENT

Lauren shared that the Health Department is seeing Campylobacter and flu. Pneumonia is 10x the normal rate for the year, and RSV is rising among pediatric patients.

REVIEW OF AMR EMERGENCY RESPONSES

Mac shared AMR numbers for October 2024. Overall, AMR saw 90.88% compliance and had 38 mutual aid assists.

REVIEW OF FIRE EMERGENCY RESPONSES

DuPlantis shared numbers for Fire for October 2024. District 3 continues to have slowest response rate with only 35% in compliance. Fire is looking to alter dispatch to help with

response.

Maggie shared that there have been YTD 157 activations for STEMI. May through September saw 100% on time-to-device in under 90 minutes. Total EMS volume is over 16,000.
