COI HEALTH DEPARTMENT

Lauren shared that the Health Department is mostly seeing Influenza A, mostly in 5-14 year olds. COVID is rising nationally along with norovirus. There are several suspect TB cases currently.

REVIEW OF AMR EMERGENCY RESPONSES

Mac shared the numbers for November 2024. There was only one Priority 1 call over 15 minutes, and overall compliance was 89.73%.

REVIEW OF FIRE EMERGENCY RESPONSES

Craig shared that Fire's numbers were sent out ahead of time and that similar trends were seen for the month. Fire is changing their data dashboard and utilizing criteria-based dispatching for responses.

MEDICAL DIRECTOR REPORT

Dr. Gustafson discussed that he believes the modified response will be beneficial moving forward.

CENTERPOINT UPDATES

Maggie shared that there were 171 total STEMI activations; 47% were EMS. Quarter 3 and 4 saw 100% for first medical contact to device times.

Dante shared that the EOC and MRC were activated/on-call for the blizzard that the region experienced. Continuing to monitor activities and needs during the storm.
