COI HEALTH DEPARTMENT

Lauren discussed that the department is currently dealing with some TB and pertussis cases. Flu cases are lower. We have had calls discussing measles, but we do not have an active case in our region yet. The group then discussed funding after recent cuts by the federal government.

REVIEW OF AMR EMERGENCY RESPONSES

AMR reviewed January and February numbers. There were 2 instances of calls that took greater than 15 minutes. In January, there was 87.16% compliance for response time; in February, compliance was 87.57%,
