A. Determine final payment due date

1. \$14,500 has been deposited from students so far.
2. Three students are behind on payments
 1. One is the student who joined late (he's made the deposit)
 1. Cassy and Patric will meet with the student and parent to investigate their situation.
 2. Patric said he would like to give the group a final payment deadline if they can't make the initial payment plan.
 3. If one student drops, we can still purchase ten tickets as a group (ten is the minimum).
3. *Jeannae moved that we announce the final payment is due on May 7th if the original payment schedule wasn't completed by then already. Sabastian seconded the motion. All members in attendance showed their support by a show of hands.*

B. Approve amount for ticket expenditure/purchase

1. \$1979.41/ ticket
 1. 11 tickets for a total of \$21,773.51 is expenditure on tickets
2. *Jeannae moved to approve the payment of the invoice for 11 tickets priced at \$21,773.51. Danijela seconded the motion, and it carried with unanimous approval with show of hand by all members in attendance.*
3. We will also need to purchase travel insurance
 1. The travel insurance we purchased last year wasn't worth the money.
 1. A student needed to change their ticket, and the insurance didn't cover the change cost.
 2. Consider the types of coverage. Cassy recommends a comprehensive plan in which the travelers can cancel for any reason. Lost luggage and health are important, but it will be best to be able to cancel for any reason.
 1. Ages of travelers is important to gain accurate quotes for insurance.

C. Assign one or two members to select travel insurance

1. Jeannae and Danijela started investigating options.

D. Determine and authorize amount for travel insurance expenditure

1. *Danijela moved to approve the expenditure of up to \$300 per traveler for travel insurance. Sabastian seconded the motion and all members in attendance showed their support of the motion with a show of hands.*
