

o New permits and regulations have been approved by the committee to be during the period of June 1 – August 17, 2026. The Committee will focus on mobile food units, temporary food vendors, and short-term rentals. Proposed \$500 application fee for temporary short-term rental approvals to include room rentals, basement spaces, and ADUs. Streamlined licensing and expanded permitting will be a project that staff will begin having internal

discussions about.

2. Website Development:

The Communications sub-committee created the Trail to the Trophy website (trailtotrophy.com) using Squarespace. The cost is \$276/year plus \$20 for the domain rights for 2 years. The site will allow for volunteer sign-ups, an event calendar, potential e-commerce, promotion of local businesses and accommodations.
