1. Josh emailed with Parks Department and received response that management company switched from plastic to aluminum cups, which are washed or recycled if they are damaged. Have met with MARC about composting and considered applying for SWMD grant but decided not feasible due to not generating enough food waste for machinery. Staff attempts to limit food purchasing to all that is needed. Applied (?) for grant for partnership with KC Can Compost.
 1. Agreed that partnership with Bold ReUse no longer seems like a good goal, appears Arena is making successful attempts at limiting disposable cup waste
 2. Plan to discuss commission priorities next meeting to decide on new focus for the commission
