APPROVAL OF MEETING MINUTES

COI HEALTH DEPARTMENT

Lauren shared that Health is mainly seeing salmonella, campylobacter, and pertussis.

Nationally, we are seeing a rise in Norovirus and RSV. Flu is relatively low at this time in our area.

REVIEW OF AMR EMERGENCY RESPONSES

Mac shared data for October 2025. AMR had zero priority calls that were over 15 minutes.

2,368 calls total. AMR is starting their move on December 15 and expect to be fully moved in January 2026.

REVIEW OF FIRE EMERGENCY RESPONSES

John shared that call volume is down 12% for the year with the largest call volume for EMS loading assistance. Still working with new reporting system to tease out data.

MEDICAL DIRECTOR REPORT

Nothing to add at this time.

CENTERPOINT UPDATES

Maggie shared that Centerpoint had 187 STEMI activations, 106 from EMS. Quarters 2 and 3 were at 100% for first medical contact in 90 minutes or less.

REGIONAL EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS REPORT

Dante shared that Emergency Preparedness is still focused on preparations for FIFA with activities for CERT and MRC.

ARCH CO-RESPONDER PROGRAM UPDATE

John shared that ARCH has moved to use of HealthCall. They are working with insurance companies on referrals for those with frequent EMS use. A social worker intern will be joining ARCH soon. Discussion with the group on the move to Pulsara by EMS, first responders, and Centerpoint.
