COI HEALTH DEPARTMENT

September saw tickborne illnesses, shigella, and a decrease in pertussis. Influenza B has been prevalent in our jurisdiction so far this season.

CENTERPOINT UPDATES

Maggie shared that there have been 154 STEMI activations year-to-date with 57% from EMS. July and August saw that 100% of First Medical Contact time was less than 90 minutes, which is the goal. In October, Centerpoint will have EMS education with a heart dissection for all interested.
