I. Roll Call/Call to Order

II. Approve prior minutes

- a. Jeannae moved to approve the May minutes and Chad seconded. All voting members in attendance voted their approval by a show of hands.*

III. Mayor King introduction

- a. Liaison to the committee.
 - i. Jeannae asked if the Mayor wants to join us for the 50th Anniversary trip to Higashimurayama. He responded that he will consider the offer.

IV. American Student Exchange Updates

- a. Danijela has been providing detailed updates in the group chat which includes some committee members, Danijela, and parents of the exchange students. Anyone on the committee can join the Line chat if they want to receive the updates.

A. Vote on student leftover funds

- a. Fundraiser profits from the GoFundMe and the Market Day went to the student delegates before they left Kansas City (approx. \$170 / student). The leftover funds we have come from the amount that the students paid for the trip, less the cost of all services provided (tickets, insurance, lessons, etc). Once balanced out, we have money leftover which accounts to approximately \$146 per student. Should we reimburse the students evenly? Jeannae suggested we ask the student delegates to vote on how JSCC uses the money. Potential options:

- i. Use on exchange activities when students come here
 - ii. Refund the money evenly
 - iii. Invest in JSCC's savings fund
- b. Is there precedence for asking the students to vote on how to use the money?
 - i. Jeannae doesn't know of any. Dustin suggested planning for this circumstance in the future and creating an official guideline.
- c. The discussion was tabled until Danijela is back from the exchange trip.

V. Independence Exchange Planning – JSCC hosted events

- a. Key Dates – try to have larger attendance than last year
 - i. Welcome Party
 - 1. August 2nd (Sunday)
 - ii. Farewell Party
 - 1. August 14th Potluck (Friday)
- b. Check on the following
 - i. Confirm Truman Memorial Building availability.
 - 1. Meeting room and museum should be up and running by our exchange parties in August. Jeannae added our event to the calendar.
 - ii. Need to contact ice rink on cost options
- c. Event planning and committee availability.
 - i. Dustin sent out a signup to committee members to volunteer their time and chaperone the student activities for the day.
- d. *Budget vote*
 - i. Chad: we currently have \$9,193.54 in the checking account.
 - ii. Last year we budgeted “not to exceed \$5,000 on student activities”.
 - iii. *Jeannae made a motion that the student exchange budget shall not exceed a budget of \$5000 for the 2026 student exchange activities in our host city. Laura seconded. All voting members in attendance showed their approval with raised hands.*

VI. Uptown Matsuri Sub-committee

- a. Potential date - Saturday November 7th
- b. Planning needs to start
- c. Dustin will submit for the Japan Foundation cultural grant. Truman Heartland Foundation will accept on our behalf and will deposit into our account. The grant generally pays for the expenses incurred by putting on the event.
